## Agenda & Notes: Business meeting April 2, 2020

## Synopsis:

Our first all online business meeting was a success – we had 13 participants, which is great! We used Google Hangouts via the East Kingdom's G-Suite. The one awkwardness is that Google Meet only shows you about 4 people at a time, so you have to say something to get noticed instead of just raising a hand. We got through the agenda smoothly. Important things to note:

I. Online Business meeting. This meeting is our first fully online meeting.

- A. The BoD has published rules for holding this meeting. They have also removed some of their initial rules, which included recording the meeting, though they suggest we do record it.
- B. Please wait for others to finish speaking or raise your hand, so that we do not have everyone speaking at once. It is very difficult to differentiate what anyone is saying when people all speak at once.
  Notes We discovered this is not as easy as it sounds, as Google Meet only lets

you see about 4 of the participants at a time. Sometimes it is necessary to use the Chat feature.

- D. We will keep this first meeting simple, and will hold off on working on the charter until next meeting.
- II. Officer reports (allotted 15 minutes)
  - A. Chamberlain: No updates to report. There are still some shire favors around somewhere (and I have some as well), and we still have the boxes of donations to process when it's safe to do so.

- H. Herald: Vacant (If interested let the seneschal know) **Discussion**: Viola is interested in learning more about the office, but is not ready to step up at this time.
- I. MoAS

The kingdom MoAS office is helping facilitate online A&S classes, and recently had their first virtual A&S display. They are always looking for people interested in teaching virtual classes, and can give help and guidance to anyone interested, but unsure about the process or technology.

I am trying to come up with A&S activities to help bring people together virtually during this isolation.

We will be doing a secret Santa style A&S swap. I will be sending out a survey from to the Shire, and anyone interested can fill it out and be a part of the swap. The time frame will be 2 months to complete the item. Requirements are that the item must be mostly hand made, SCA appropriate (but not necessarily period), and made primarily from supplies you already have.

I am also putting together a menu and recipes for a virtual feast. The goal is for easy recipes that most of us already have, or can easily get during the few grocery trips we are making. The goal is for the recipes to be sent enough in advance so even if you are only going to the grocery store 2x per month, you should be ok, without making a special trip. For the actual feast, those joining us are encouraged to use feastgear and set up as they might at an SCA feast.

- J. MoL nothing to report
- K. Secretarie last month's meeting notes were distributed in a timely fashion.
- L. Social Media deputy: Vacant (If interested let the seneschal know)
- M. Webminister: Added text canceling all face-to-face gatherings on the website so that it displays on every webpage. Alison updated the calendar as well.
- III. Covid-19 changes to the East Kingdom's schedule and events
  - A. Coronation and Crown Tourney: Both scheduled for May 21-25th (Memorial weekend) at War of the Roses in NY. **Discussion**: The peerage of one of our members will <u>not</u> be taking place at this event, we will let folks know when we have a date. There is a HHD member who will be called into court at this event. Concern was expressed that the Covid crisis would still be ongoing at this time, and that this event might not be able to take place.
  - B. EK Curia scheduled SRWC in NJ May 29-31st.
  - C. Pennsic: No news right now. The staff plan to meet at Aethelmearc War Camp, or meet virtually if this War Camp is not held. We should hear shortly after that if there are changes to Pennsic this year.
- IV. Hartshorn-dale events/demos
  - A. Shire Wars. New Prospectus. **Discussion**: We are still happy support this event, and as we voted last meeting, we did not vote again, the prospectus offered no major changes
  - B. Commons
    - 1. June 14th: Brandr was going to autocrat. Should we put this on hold?
    - 2. Sept 13th: Attila was going to autocrat. If the June one is put on hold, should this one be scheduled at the 4H site, so that we can use that site this year?
    - 3. **Discussion**: We will continue to consider if these are viable, but will change venue from the prior plan which was to hold the June Commons at the 4H club, moving that venue to the September Commons. Diana will send the information on the rates at the 4H club to Attila, who will call and check on the date availability. For June, we will wait and see what happens with Social Distancing and the Covid response, but keep the

date on our calendar. If we decide to hold it, we can always make a last minute reservation at the Lower Providence Park, or another park, since we already voted on this.

- C. Event for next spring. Milissent to autocrat. Is there any news? **Discussion**: Millisent was not present, and she had planned to meet with folks from Iron Bog in March, but the event they were meeting at was canceled. We will hold this as an agenda item until we hear more.
- D. GoFourth demo in Pottstown. Eleanor to autocrat. I have not had any other updates on gofourth yet. I've not held any planning meetings since it's not certain but I have written down some brainstorms. If you want them I can email them out later. **Discussion**: We would like to hear Eleanor's ideas, and look forward to hearing them.
