"A&S: Nothing new to report

Herald: Working on getting the Shire's device & name out from under Lord Alexander's name and passed to the shire.

Exchequer: Nothing new to report

Chatelaine: Laid up after surgery, but will be making calls to the local colleges getting information on clubs and possible demo opportunities.

Seneschal: We are official as of 12th night an incpt. Shire. We are holding our first business meeting on the 16th of January at 7pm. Fencing will be happening at the same time in other room. Several things will be going on such as setting up a group to discuss policy and bylaws. I will be sending in my 1st report to Kingdom this week as well.

Archery Note: Indoor archery will again be starting up on 13th starting at 7pm going 9pm unless no one shows by 8pm"

During the Archer's Forde report Alexander was reminded that the shire can have a subset of Hartshorn-dale's checking account if they need it to deposit funds.

The Archer's Forde senechal was also asked if Archery practices for their group could be posted to the Hartshorn-dale list. Archery occurs the second and fourth Mondays. When it was noted that the new shire does not currently have much loaner equipment, it was suggested that they should contact the Archery marshal, as we might have extras we could lend them.

Demos and Events:

There are currently 3 upcoming events.

1. Archer's Forde brewing event:

Alexander reported that the event planning is currently on schedule. They will talk more about it at the Archer's Forde business meeting in Jan., and begin prepping then. They have a lot of leftover supplies., which is why they did not need much money for the event (only a hundred dollars). Friar Will will be coordinating classes and is getting a list together. They hope to have the EK Brewers guild do a paneling.

2. Artisan's challenge

Elizabet reported that she is getting ready to do some more advertising for the event. Otherwise, everything is going well. They have the supplies they need (since the last one was canceled). Elizabet stressed that she is very open to someone taking over the role of autocrat for the event after this year. She wants someone else from the group to autocrat the event because she does not want it to become one person's event. She wants the group to have ownership of it.

Diana mentioned that she sent the church a contribution from the shire.

3. Dining with Liz

The menu was revamped on Tuesday and Kathryn says it is much better now. They are still looking for a few more recipes. Diana sent (will send?) an e-mail to ACCEPS so they can get the event up on their site. Andrew is waiting to receive information about the event for the event website. It is live now, but contains no information yet. However, now that the event has a new menu and schedule, this can be done. Fum indicated that he is willing to do commedia at the event. There is a dance list for the event that will be sent to Sabine. Kathryn has also asked Sabine about having madrigals at the event.

Alexander noted that they have a musically inclined person in Archer's Forde, and we wanted to know if she was interested in performing at the event, or at Hartshorn-dales dance practice. He will contact her to see. Alexander did mention

that she would need a ride to any events or practices.

Bhakail has started dance practice every second and fourth Tuesday at their Stage One site in Media. It alternates with their heavy practices at that site.

New/Old Shire Business:

1. Welcome to Archer's Ford

The Archer's Forde seneschal was contacted by James from Silver Rylle. He will be the seneschal for that group, and wants to reach out to neighboring groups to see if they are interested in helping out at the Union Canal demo in May. Alexander will confirm the date of that event for us. Silver Rylle wants to pull other groups into because last year the event was very large, pulling in so many people that the group could not keep up. As a result, they really need more people to work the demo. The event is a camping event, and it allows demonstrations for archery, thrown weapons, etc. Alexander said he will keep our group informed. It was suggested that he also specifically keep our demo-co-ordinator informed.

The group suggested that he encourage the seneschal of Silver Rylle to mention the demo event on the EK seneschals list to avoid conflict.

Alexander also noted that the chatelaine of Archer's Forde will be working on contacting colleges, including attempting to regaining a presence on Kutztown's campus. They will also be going around to four other colleges in the area, perhaps to do community days events or students club days. This idea sparked discussion about doing something on West Chester's campus, as we have a shire member who works there.

2. Discussion of what people would like to see happening in the shire

When asked if there were things people would like to see happening in Hartshorn-dale, A&S gatherings seemed to be a popular idea. Elizabet noted that these gatherings can happen and have been happening in the past on Monday's at fencing practices. Kathryn also offered her home as a gathering place. There is also plenty of room at dining with Lorenzo meetings. These occur two tuesday's every month (Note: the dates of Dining with Lorenzo meetings need to be updated on the shire calendar. Andrew said he would take care of that). One possible topic for an A&S workshop was a get together for people who do chain mail.

Kathryn asked that if people noticed interesting events in line with the SCA's mission, that they post about them to the shire list and facebook page. If everyone helps with this, we can get a nice selection of events. online Diana noted that this information would be nice to have on the website, and Andrew said he could make

this happen.

Some upcoming events include a Hildegard of Bingen inspired concert in Philadelphia on January 29th, 7:30 at the Cathedral in Philadelphia. Kathryn will post this to the e-mail list. The Pompeii exhibit at the Franklin institute was also mentioned.
