New/Old Shire Business:

Shire Wars

- The Shire Wars 4 revised proposal and event announcement were submitted and discussed at the event. 4 shires will be hosting (Silver Rylle will not be participating)
- The vote to participate in the event was YES
- We will ask the autocrat to add the size of the cabins to the event announcement
- The autocrat of Shire Wars is also still looking into using ACEPS

- The autocrat will also add to the announcement who the check for the event site fee should be out to.
- Questions were also raised about the existence of an event website, and if there will be youth rapier at the event.

Dining With Elizabeth

- Dining with Elizabeth (Saturday June 28th) is on schedule so far. Cooking can occur at the church on Friday June 27th, with set up of the outside tents that evening, probably c. 5 or 6 PM. Can Shire afford pizza or should we collect donations of the participants?
- It was also suggested that the shire should bring up the issue of event scheduling with the kingdom due to the unfortunate scheduling of SRWC opposite Dining with Elizabeth.

Artisans Row/Challenge

- Date: June 2015, the first weekend.
- Location: Willow Grove Day camp
- Fee Structure: \$15 day trip, \$20 camping, \$10 feast.
- Naomi will bring a formal bid to next months shire meeting. This will be the 2nd bid, as she presented the event last month (April). She has since visited the site, which she says is very nice! It has a good kitchen, and bathrooms, showers, and a pool.
- Some information about this event was included in April's meeting minutes.
- New information presented at this meeting includes:
 - There is some risk of flooding if there is a big storm, due to the nature of the ground and the camp, but there are areas higher up for tents, and indoor sleeping areas.
 - This is a weekend long event, and activities will likely be scheduled on Sunday.
 - There will be no martial activities planned, but, at a suggestion Naomi may look into martial A&S demonstrations.
 - Each artisans row area will have its own coordinator.
 - There will be challenges, and a set time for those giving and accepting challenges to discuss them.
 - This event will likely be an East Kingdom University. We will need to share profits with the kingdom, but the EKU also has money it can give groups for event expenses.
 - Naomi will also be trying to make this an RP.
 - The break even number is 200 people.
 - The event site is on Bhakail land, but Bhakail has given us the OK to hold the event.
 - Naomi has asked someone to cook dayboard and is waiting for a reply.
 - Casey (Janos) who is doing the feast will have space for people who want to learn to work in the kitchen with him. People can contact him about this.
