Archer's Forde Report: Lord Alexander Makerystine- Seneschal

A&S: new projects have been starting, to name a few, brewing ,sewing, woodwork, & fiber arts.

Herald: A personal name, device, & badge was submitted at war this year for a member of the shire. I also consulted on a few names and devices with other people.

Exchequer: Still no money officially, \$60 unofficially

Webmistress: Our web page is up and running still, changing it off and on to support local events in our announcements.

Chatelaine: A few returning to SCA people have contacted us since they live in our area and we gave them information on when our meetings are.

Seneschal: No meeting was held in August, due to Pennsic. I have sent in our ideas about running Shire Wars to the Shire Wars yahoo group. Alexander also plans to talk with the other shire seneschals at Shire Wars about running the event next time.

When asked, Alexander reported that things are on track for Shire Wars. Alexander said that there were a few bumps, but those were ironed out.

New/Old Shire Business:

Vote on new fencing Marshal – Jenevieve was unanimously elected. Atilla will serve as her deputy.

Vote on proposed changes for charter. The changes were reviewed at the meeting and approved with two small changes (changes in bold)

- 8.4 Messages posted to the official shire e-mail list can be considered official communications, if they are designated *as such* by the shire officer.
- 9.3 says "Early in the bid process the seneschal should post the event information on the Seneschal's list in an attempt to minimize event conflict. Add the following text: *The bidding autocrat should provide the seneschal with the text of an e-mail for this purpose.*

The vote to approve the charter as modified was unanimous.

We will start putting old charters on the server for archival purposes (not on the public website). On the server we will have a clean copy of the 2011 charter, a copy of the charter with changes indicated in red from 2011-2014, and a clean copy of the 2014 charter (which will be also on the public website)

Events:

Archer's Forde circulated their bid for the Brewing Festival of Saint Aegir.

<u>Discussion:</u> The group may increase food expenses if preregistration numbers indicate there will be more people than anticipated. The group has a larger/more central site, and hopes to attract more people to the event than in previous years. When asked about related expenses (which was left blank) the group said that they don't anticipate any of those, as they have things left over from last time. When asked who was running gate (as two names were listed) the group said that Maryam would be the lead person running gate, assisted by Lady Erna. It was suggested that this event get posted in the EK gazette, and send out multiple posts calling for teachers to e-mail lists, as this is another way of advertising for the event.

Naomi provided updates on the Artisans Village Event (June 5-7 at the Willow Grove Day Camp)

- One challenge has already been offered, another was offered at the meeting.
- We need to get the word out quickly to people, especially as Metalsmiths Symposium will be against our event.
- It was suggested that Naomi create an event facebook page.
- She is still looking into whether it will be a wet or dry or discretely damp site.
- There will likely be informal bardic on Friday after set up, and maybe some informal dancing too.
