# Fencing Marshal:

The following is the updated Hartshorn-dale Rapier Marshal's report covering the month of February and March up till the 25<sup>th</sup>.

For February; we had the church hall on Feb 2nd, 9<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, and 23<sup>rd</sup>. One practice was cut short due to weather but was not cancelled through the church.

For March; we had the church hall on March 2nd, 9<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, and 23<sup>rd</sup> (the 30<sup>th</sup> is planned).

We collected \$134.00 for dues in February. We collected \$152 for dues in March (one week dues pending). Separate checks for \$134.00 and \$152.00 have been made for deposit. The March 30<sup>th</sup> dues will be added to April. No incidents to report. We maintain 3 marshals as regular attenders (myself, Attila and James O'Galleghure) with assistance of Alexander from Archer's Ford.

For February attendance: we had 9-11 fencers each week. Two collegiate fencers have joined us. They are enjoying it and learning how our style is different than Olympic style. Welcome Jordan and James! We also had a high ranking rapier fighter visiting from Atlantia. Unfortunately weather cut her visit short, but she enjoyed meeting everyone.

As reported in earlier months, we are in need of loaner gear. "Darkwood Armory" has the least expensive mask with reasonable priced gloves. Update on needs: 2 masks (\$60.00 each) and 2 pair of gloves (\$30.00 each). Several

fencers are adding their own orders to combine shipping. The fair distribution of shipping is \$7.00 added to masks and \$3.00 for gloves. We are asking for a total of \$202.00 to cover cost.

Attila and I continue to work toward our Youth Fencing Marshallate. We sent information for the background checks through the Society. It is currently being processed.
