Updates continue to the Artisans' Village site, and there are some conversations on the web minister's e-mail list about hosting sites like it on the <u>eastkingdom.org</u> site in the future. This would allow groups to stop paying for website hosting for these event pages, now that all group sites are on eastkingdom.org. Andrew is following the conversations, and he will report back with news, as policies would need to be developed for this, particularly regarding who can edit the site, as only the seneschal and web minister can currently edit group webpages according to current policy. Alexander mentioned that it might be desirable to move the Shire Wars website to eastkingdom.org. Others at the meeting agreed, and it was noted that the charter for shire wars should include a web minster position.

Archer's Ford Report

A few highlights are below. The full meeting minutes from Archer's Ford Dec. meeting can be found on the group's website:

- There have been two inquiries on the current status of the Shire's bid to become full-fledged or if the Kingdom needed more from us. No response from either the Kingdom Seneschal or the Deputy of New Groups.
- Thane Alexander will be stepping down after the election of a new Seneschal in January
- Silver Rylle has asked for approval to run an Archery/Thrown Weapons event within the boundaries of the Archer's Ford Shire. This event was brought up by Alexander at November's Hartshorn-dale shire meeting. During the December meeting in Archer's Ford, a vote was held, and the Shire agreed to allow the event to happen within their borders. However, those present at the meeting agreed that more information was needed from Silver Rylle before they could commit to providing any money or agreement to co-share the event.
