3. New Business

- a. From Exchequer:
 - i. The SCA Inc has asked that we have a new Exchequer before they pass our request for Barony status to the BOD. Our Kingdom does not have term limits currently for this office but is moving to establish them at the request of SCA Inc. Our Charter specifies that if an officer needs to leave before the end of their term that someone should be nominated at a business meeting, and then a vote held at the next meeting.

I have asked Elysabeth Underhill (Larissa Gordon) to run for this position. She is an experienced officer at the Kingdom level, and has been a member of our group since her days at Ursinus college. I think she will do an outstanding job. She is prepared to continue in this job when it comes up for election next fall.

My new deputy Ivette will remain as a deputy exchequer and I will continue as a deputy exchequer after May 5th, training them both until they are ready to take over completely. This solution has the complete support of the Kingdom Seneschal & Kingdom Exchequer.
