Feast

The feast was delicious. A full menu with descriptions is below (provided by the Dining with Lorenzo cooking group).

The Forme of Cury John Rylands Library Cookbook of the Chefs of King Richard II circa 1390

We are working from the oldest version, hand written by his Chefs on fine vellum, of their working recipes.

Our theme for the feast is fall and hunting. Hence our feast name of Harts & Horns, and indeed our Shire's name Hartshorn-dale, chosen more than 30 years ago, from medieval English place names.

It is the fall and there is much hunting of game and gathering of autumn bounty, and so our feast begins with **Venison**. Be assured that our deer are the finest in the land being raised by hand and fed exclusively on excellent food and so sent to us for our delight.

Mushrooms are everywhere in the forest and careful hunters have brought us excellent fare for our feast.

Cameline (or CInnamon Sauce) is a staple in every medieval kitchen. Our recipe focuses on the gravy quality of the sauce with its pungent spices and splash of vinegar.

A pungent pairing for the sweet venison & sauce is "*salat*" full of greens & herbs & onions of the season.

Chyces is a vegetarian dish with chickpeas to delight the senses with gentle spices.

Blanc Manger was a standard dish in every medieval kitchen. Here the recipe calls for using the juice from stewing the chicken in herbs to make the almond milk. The flavors carry through nicely. Rice is cooked in the almond milk to al-dente and then more almond milk and the chicken are added and it is cooked as risotto to a creamy texture.

Almonds fried with saffron are sprinkled on top.

Fungus are perfectly matched with leeks in this excellent recipe.

Tart de Bry (brie cheese) is a wonderful example of meatless entries that were served on fish days.

Bursews is an extraordinary dish, made by slow roasting pork with warm medieval spices, then grinding the pork, rolling it in batter and deep frying it. Fried foods were most often served with the last course or remove.

Here it is paired with *Musarda di Fruita*, a remarkable condiment which combines sweet and sour elements perfectly. Dried apricot and cherries are combined with ginger & mustard, in both powdered and wet forms, and white wine.

Peers in Confit is a classic medieval dessert, made exceptional by the choice of the wine in which they are stewed.

Cryspals is a mystery recipe that includes fried pastry, here in our interpretation, deep fried on horn cones like cannoli, and then served with or stuffed with a custard. Here are two custards, almond and cherry, to try with our horn cryspals.

1) Timeline for Baronial Seat Nominations

a. Seneschal calls for Letters of Intent starting 10/6. Formal e-mail will be sent out to populace ASAP.

b. Nominations last two months.

c. The number (but not name) of nominees will be mentioned at the November business meeting.

d. The December business meeting is the last date for nominations to be accepted. Letters of intent and the names of nominees will be shared at that point. This way a candidate who declares early will not have a formal advantage.

e. After the December meeting the seneschal will talk to kingdom about running polling. A polling format will be decided on at the December

meeting. Candidate meet and greets will be scheduled after the December meeting.

2) Additional Information About Running for Baronial Seat

a. No one may hold a primary shire office during their official candidacy without the permission of the crown.

b. The baronial seat cannot be exchequer or seneschal while seated

c. The kingdom's new Barony Deputy Officers says that there are no formal rules for Letters of Intent (LOI's). The only requirement is to state your intent for running. Beyond that, it is up to the candidate. Candidates may wish to talk about their willingness and suitability for the role.

3) Investiture

a. Desired timeline is for Investiture to occur at next year's Hearts and Horns event. Preferred date is the second week in November, but ultimately it will have to be acceptable to the royal heirs when chosen. Seneschal will reserve the desired date on the new kingdom event prep calendar.

b. James will put out a call for Event Stewards to bid on the event.

c. Note that the Event Steward can come from outside the shire, as long as they have a deputy in the shire.

d. We prefer that the Event Steward is not a candidate for office, but if we have trouble getting bids for the event in the next two weeks, we can have a potential candidate help get planning going on a temporary basis.

--Looking at examples of other baronial coronets, the group chose one it liked (Iron Bog's leather coronnet). The exemplar had a heraldic device on the front (which the group wants to be slightly larger than the exemplar)

--Around the sides we are looking for some combination of hunters horns and stag horns. We will ask the artisan for some drawing/examples to pick from.

--Coronets must be adjustable, and designs on the back may want to be simpler to take this into account.

--Colors should be majority blue/yellow. Color of pearls will depend on the design of the coronet, but the group is open to acquiring real pearls as well as using colored stones.
